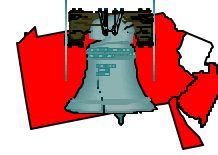

Dale has extensive experience in the interview techniques that law enforcement and intelligence services use in their profiling of suspects, witnesses, informants, etc. He has converted this expertise into a unique, and highly in-demand business of transferring these techniques to commercial companies. For example, he has trained the security staff (formerly “bouncers,” now SpecOps veterans) of several prestigious entertainment venues in techniques to identify threats from the customers as well as the employees of the venues
